He notified dispatch to send the Fire Department, then approached the burning complex. He entered the building and forced open the apartment doors that were locked, ensuring a rapid evacuation.

He was joined by Cst. Mitchell and Cst. LeBlue, who also entered the burning complex, checking the apartments for occupants.

When the Fire Department arrived, all of the apartments that could be checked for occupants had been checked and evacuated.

As a result of the responsive actions of Cst. Minielly, Cst. Mitchell, and Cst. LeBlue no casualties resulted from the fire.

These three Constables carried out a Distinguished Act of Bravery risking their lives in the Preservation of the Lives of Others.
